



CANADIAN IMMIGRATION MEDICAL : CLIENT HAND OUT

Our Team will walk you through the process, ensuring you are aware of what needs to happen next and where you should to go.

THE DAY OF THE EXAMINATION :

- On arrival, you will be asked to provide your passport and sign a consent form ensuring we are able to continue with the medical as planned.
- You will be given forms to complete for blood work and x-rays.
- You will have a digital photo taken, to capture you directly onto the online e-medical system.
- You will be asked to provide a urine sample for testing of kidney functionality.
- The Sister will take a couple of measurements and discuss the results of the urine screening test.
- You will be taken to the x-ray department in order that the x-ray can be taken.
- Please return to our Reception once you have the x-ray in hand.
- You will be taken to the Doctor for the examination.
- Please return to our Reception once the examination has been completed.
- You will be taken to the Laboratory for blood work
- Please return to our Reception once this has been completed.
- You will receive confirmation that you have started the medical examination in the form of an **Information Sheet** that will be printed and given to you.

SUBMISSION OF REPORTS REQUESTED / REFERRAL LETTER :

Any medical reports that have been requested by the Doctor will delay the submission to the CIC.

SUBMISSION OF CASE TO THE IRCC (Immigration Refugees and Citizenship Canada):

- Once all the results have been received, normally 5 to 10 working days (without the need for any additional reports), the case will be submitted to the IRCC.
- You will receive via the nominated email address, an updated **Information Sheet** confirming this submission, noting that the examination statuses have changed from in progress / not started to completed.
- You will also receive a 5 to 7 page document **Health Case Details**. These were the questions that were asked during the Consultation and is supplied to ensure you are aware of any health issues that have been identified and discussed, the results are also noted in this report.
- We suggest to keep the **Health Case Details** for your records, and submit the **Information Sheet** as proof that you have been for the medical to the IRCC / your immigration consultation / immigration lawyer etc

Please Note:

- Once your health examination results have been submitted to the IRCC, any further queries about your visa application and / or your health examination results should be directed to your IRCC visa officer. Staff at a panel clinic will not be able to help you with these queries.

WHAT TO DO IF THE CASE IS RETURNED FROM THE IRCC:

- In the event, further health examinations / additional information is required, you will be notified by CIC directly once your case has been assessed. For further information on IRCC's health assessment process, please refer to their website at: <http://www.cic.gc.ca>
- Please note, we are not made aware of any returns until the candidate makes contact with us to inform us of this return, however we will gladly assist where possible. To note, there may be additional fees applicable.
